







Select the applications you want your users to have access to. Uncheck any applications that you don't want to allow access to.





<u>OPTIONAL:</u> Tap and hold apps to enable Auto Launch on boot:

<u>OPTIONAL</u>: Tap the *Menu* icon and *Change Password* to change the default password of "aml".










OPTIONAL: Add a website to Lockdown Home screen


- Make sure website url has "https://"
- Website will launch in default browser








Tap the Menu button, then select "Lockdown" from the dropdown list.




