

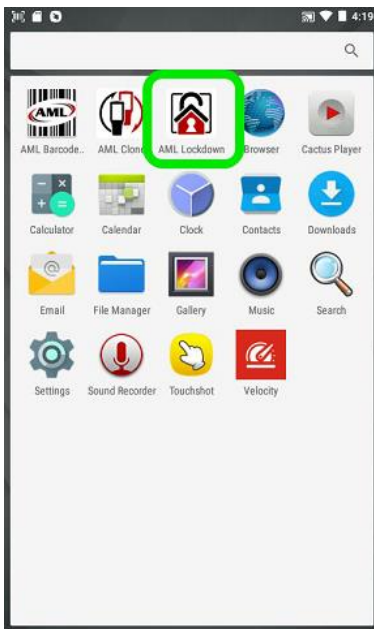


# AML Lockdown Utility



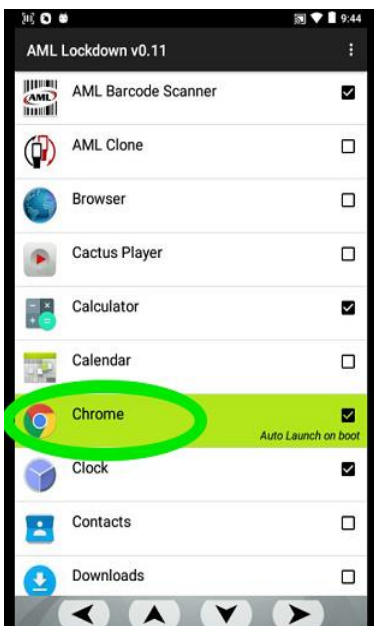
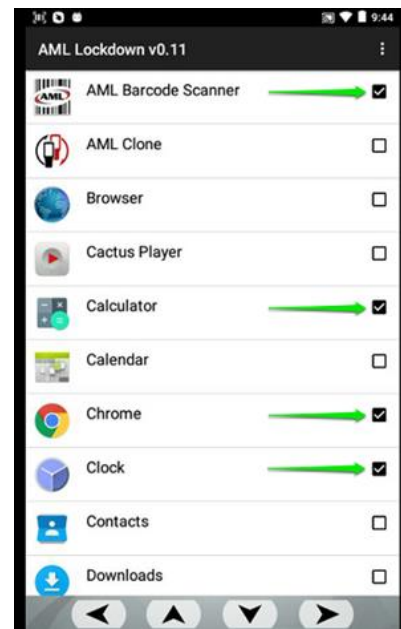

To use the AML Lock down application, begin by tapping the AML Lockdown icon on the home page.



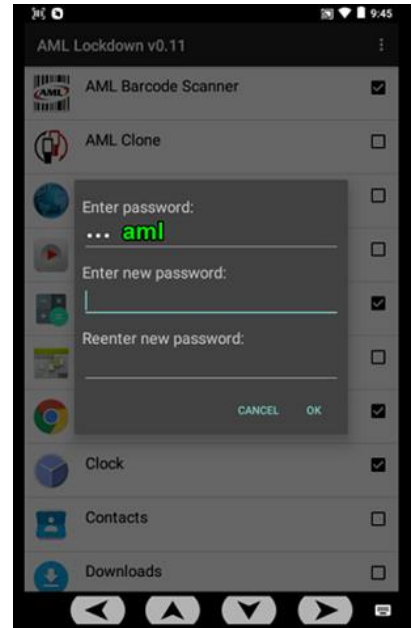
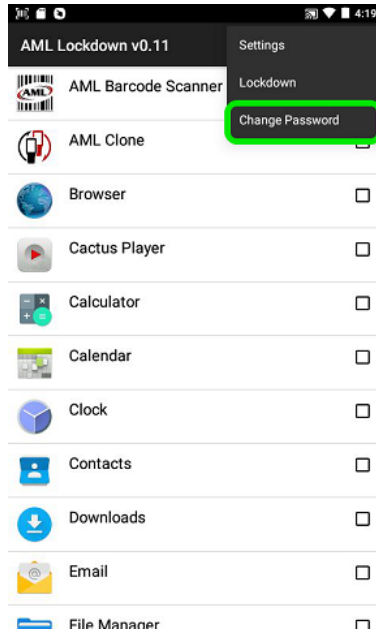
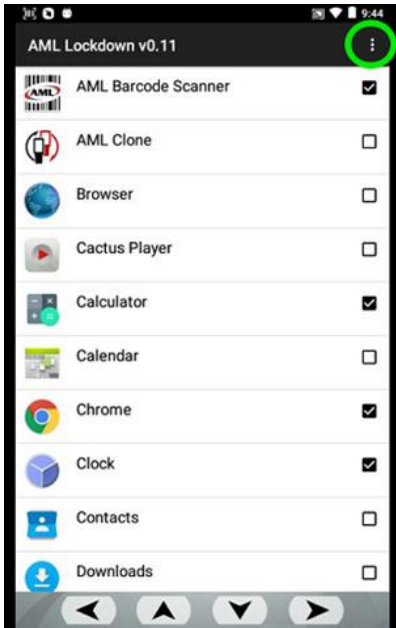

Select the applications you want your users to have access to. Uncheck any applications that you don't want to allow access to.



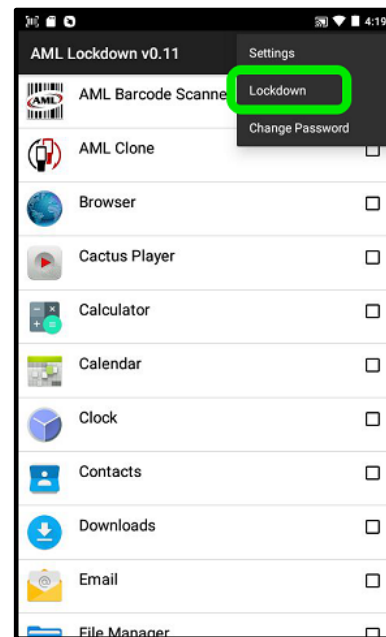
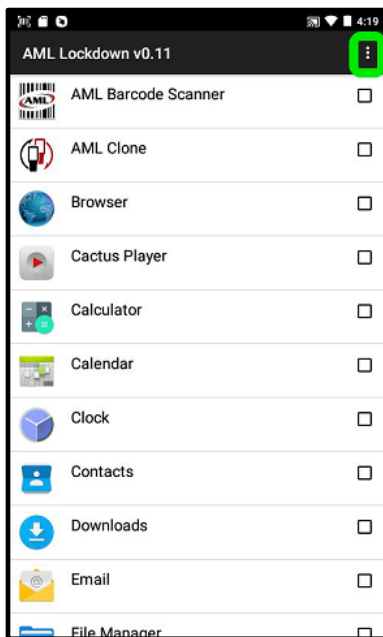
OPTIONAL: Tap and hold apps to enable *Auto Launch on boot*:


OPTIONAL: Tap the *Menu* icon and *Change Password* to change the default password of "aml".

Tap the Menu button, then select "Lockdown" from the dropdown list.





1. Select Launcher *AML Lockdown* and press the *home key*  twice.
2. Only enabled apps and user toolbar icons will be accessible.



- Note: the **user toolbar** icons allow the following:
  - *View device information and status*
  - *Adjust sound volume*
  - *Adjust brightness*
  - *Toggle Wifi on/off*



## To disable AML Lockdown

1. Hold down the *Delete/Backspace* key  to prompt for password. (The default password is "**aml**").
2. Select *Launcher3* to revert to default home screen, and press the home key  twice.
